In keeping up with the changing times, vigilance is becomming more and more important in our community. This past fall, a Foxmoor Drive residence was burglarized during broad daylight. The burglars entered the home through a rear window, opened the garage door for their vehicle and drove in. After stealing numerous large electronic items, they simply backed out and drove off without being observed.

It would be niave to think we are not under some criminal surveillance. We have heard reports of strange vehicles passing through the community, possibly casing out the neighborhood patterns. Personnaly, while walking a street during the fall, a vehicle that did not look like it belonged here, suspiciously backed into a driveway as I walked by, as if to block view of its tags, then drove off after I walked by. We all need to be aware of our surroundings and report suspicious activity to the authority. Hopefully we can lessen criminal activity here by making Foxmoor a less easy target.

The condition of the property at 1816 Foxbrook Drive, presently for sale, is a frequent source of complaints. In the process of filing a lien on the property, we learned the house is in forclosure and later learned the lien was held up due to bankruptcy. Until this is resolved, we do not expext any cooperation from the homeowner for mailbox repair etc. We share your frustration and are proceeding under the guidance of our attorney.

By now, you are all aware of our new speed limit signage at the entrance of the subdivision. This is an excellent first step in our efforts to control speeding. We reach out to all homeowners to obey the posted speed limit for the safety of all within our community.

The Red Route Expansion of I-540

The planned expansion of the last section of I-540 may be routed closer to Foxmoor than previously planned due to the discovery of a rare mussle in a watershed along the previously planned route.

Covenant/Bylaw Enforcement and Guidelines

One of the Board's responsibilities is responding to infractions of the Association's covenants. Common issues often requiring action include: *Trailer or boat parking in the driveway or side set-back of the house *Unlicensed vehicles parked on the property unscreened *Vehicle parking off of the paved driveway *Nuisance dog barking *Unkept lawns etc.
